THE CHURCH COVENANT

LEADER: By what common and gracious experience do we enter into spiritual fellowship with God and one another?

CONGREGATION: Having been led, as we believe, by the spirit of God to receive the Lord Jesus Christ as our Saviour and, on the profession of our faith, having been baptized in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and the Holy Spirit, we do now in the presence of God, Angels, and this assembly, most solemnly and joyfully enter into covenant with one another, as one body in Christ.

LEADER: What is the great bond of our union with God and each other?

CONGREGATION: We engage, therefore, by the aid of the Holy Spirit to walk together in Christian Love.

LEADER: What are our great privileges and duties in this, our church?

CONGREGATION: To strive for the advancement of this Church in Knowledge, Holiness, Ordinances, Discipline, and Doctrines.

LEADER: What vows do we gladly make as stewards of that which God has entrusted in us?

CONGREGATION: To contribute cheerfully and regularly to the support of the ministry, the expense of the church, the relief of the poor, and the spread of the gospel through all nations.

LEADER: For the sake of our home and our loved ones, what gracious task do we humbly assume?

CONGREGATION: We also engage to maintain family and secret devotion; to religiously educate our children, to seek salvation of our kindred and acquaintances.

LEADER: For what sake of the unsaved for whom our Saviour died, to what manner of life and conversation are we solemnly and sincerely pledged?

CONGREGATION: To walk circumspectly in the world, to be just in our dealings, faithful in our engagements, and exemplary in our deportment; to avoid tattling, backbiting, and excessive anger, to abstain from the sale of, and use of, destructive drugs or intoxicating drinks as a beverage; to shun pornography; to be zealous in our efforts to advance the Kingdom of our Saviour.

LEADER: Since one is our Master, even Christ, and we are all one body, by what fraternal ministries are we to strengthen each other and adorn the teachings of our Lord and Saviour?

CONGREGATION: We further engage to watch over one another in brotherly love; to remember one another in prayer; to aid one another in sickness and distress; to cultivate Christian sympathy in feeling and courtesy in speech; to be slow to take offense, but always ready for reconciliation and mindful of the rules of our Saviour to secure it without delay.

LEADER: What is our duty in moving from this place?

ALL: We moreover engage that when we remove from this place we will, as soon as possible, unite with some other church where we can carry out the spirit of this covenant and the principles of God's word. Fasting and Praying



1. John Wesley – Storm the throne of grace

"Have you any days of fasting and prayer? Storm the throne of grace and persevere therein, and mercy will come down."

2. John Piper – Intensification of prayer

"That's what I think fasting is at heart. It's an intensification of prayer. It's a physical explanation point at the end of the sentence, "We hunger for you to come in power." It's a cry with your body, "I really mean it, Lord! This much, I hunger for you."

3. Jentezen Franklin – A duty of the Christian

"Three duties of every Christian are giving, praying, and fasting."

4. Wesley Duewel – Fast to give yourself to prayer and meditation.

"Fasting in the Biblical sense is choosing not to partake of food because your spiritual hunger is so deep, your determination in intercession so intense, or your spiritual warfare so demanding that you have temporarily set aside even fleshly needs to give yourself to prayer and meditation."

5. Gary Rohrmayer – Feed on the Word of God

"Fasting is more about replacing than it is about abstaining — replacing normal activities with focused times of prayer and feeding on the Word of God."

6. D.L. Moody – Fast before God lays it on your heart.

"If you say 'I will fast when God lays it on my heart, you never will. You are too cold and indifferent to take the yoke upon you."

7. Fulton J. Sheen – Fasting detaches you. Prayer reattaches you.

"Fasting detaches you from this world. Prayer reattaches you to the next world."

8. Jeffrey R. Holland – Fast with purpose and devotion.

"Pray earnestly and fast with purpose and devotion. Some difficulties, like devils, do not come out save by fasting and by prayer. Ask in righteousness and you shall receive. Knock with conviction and it shall be opened unto you."
